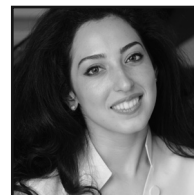
THE 2017 DEBUT SERIES SCHEDULE

Tues, Feb 7, 2017 at 8:00 pm • *Note venue: SF Conservatory of Music*
 Born in China, violinist Ning Feng won the Gold Medal at the prestigious Paganini Competition, as well as prizes at the Queen Elisabeth and Yehudi Menuhin competitions. This blazing virtuoso (with a lyrical side) has performed with such orchestras as the LA Philharmonic and Berlin Konzerthaus Orchestra in some of the world's great concert halls.

**Seong-Jin Cho, piano**

Tues, Feb 28, 2017 at 8:00 pm • *St. Mark's Lutheran Church*
 Born in 1994 in Seoul, Seong-Jin Cho is a fast-rising star. He won Gold Medals at both the 2015 Warsaw Chopin and the 2009 Hamamatsu Competitions, as well as Bronze at the 2011 Tchaikovsky (at age 16). Already in hot demand, he plays with the world's great orchestras under such conductors as Maazel, Janowski, Pletnev, Gergiev, Ashkenazy and Esa-Pekka Salonen.

**Sara Daneshpour, piano**

 This young Persian-American artist has won several international awards and has performed at such prestigious venues as the Kennedy Center, Carnegie Hall and the Moscow Conservatory. **Haochen Zhang, piano**

 This deeply musical 25-year-old Chinese pianist has entered only one international competition, the Cliburn, but there he won the Gold Medal! Since then he has performed with top orchestras (Munich, Mariinsky, London, Philadelphia, San Francisco) with such conductors as Lorin Maazel and Valery Gergiev, and is in high demand as a recitalist as well.

**Mayuko Kamio, violin**

Fri, May 5, 2017 at 8:00 pm • *St. Mark's Lutheran Church*
 Gold Medalist of Tchaikovsky Violin Competition, this "radiant talent" (*NY Times*) has a sweet, intense tone, expressive phrasing and jawdropping technique. Born in Japan, she made her concerto debut at age ten with conductor Charles Dutoit in a televised concert. Since then, she has appeared with such conductors as Mstislav Rostropovich and Zubin Mehta.
